REIMAGINING UBUNTU IN THE POST-COLONY: HEALING FORCE, OR THE END OF AN IDEA?

Date: Thursday, 25 November 2021 **Time:** 16:00-17:30 (SAST), 09:00-10:30 (EDT)

Professor Lesley Le Grange, distinguished professor in the Faculty of Education at Stellenbosch University, will be in conversation with Professor Bernard Matolino, Associate Professor in Philosophy at the University of KwaZulu-Natal.

Professor Le Grange's work is concerned with *ubuntu* as part of an indigenous knowledge framework in a decolonialised system of education, and the potential of *ubuntu* as a healing force in nature, society and the self.



Professor Matolino has raised questions about the way *ubuntu* is applied as a tool for healing, reconciliation and nation building in post-apartheid South Africa, most prominently in an article, *The End of Ubuntu*, written with Professor Wenceslaus Kwindigwi.
